Selection Process for the AFSCAN SEVC Scholarships 2025

Eligibility Criteria	 Applicants should be between 5 –15 years after graduation from veterinary school Applicants must be an active member of their Local Association Applicants should have the potential to develop, support and expand veterinary continuing education in their region Applicants should be fluent in English and/or Portuguese language Applicants must be eligible for a visa to Spain
Documents to be sent electronically as described in the announcement above	 Curriculum vitae of the applicant Letter of intent from the applicant explaining how the scholarship will benefit them and lead to satisfying above aims A letter of support from a board member of their local association stating that the applicant is an active member of the Association A letter of support from the respective AFSCAN Ambassador
Scholarship package	 Travel expenses covering pre-approved economy flight tickets Full congress registration Max 4 nights hotel accommodation
Expectations of the successful applicants	 400-word report on their experiences within 2 weeks of Congress that may be published Meeting with AFSCAN Board members if appropriate Appropriate publicity photographs taken on site and in respective country of applicant in his/her clinic Agreement on use of pictures and name for publicity
